2. Mark (which begins with the preaching of John the Baptist), and John (which begins with "in the beginning").
3. Day three of creation: waters were gathered together (the Seas); dry land appeared (Earth); grass, herbs, fruit trees. (Genesis 1:9-13)
4. Paul was on the island called Melita. (Acts 28:1-6)
5. Rhoda (Acts 12:13) (Isn't it amazing that we pray and then when God answers, we are surprised?!?!?)
6. Eutychus (Acts 20:7-12) (Did you know that the name Eutychus means 'fortunate'?)
7. Elisha (II Kings 4:18-37) Many theologians believe this was a type of CPR.

9. The book of Esther. Although His presence, and His hand upon His people are significant and mentioned frequently in the book, the name of God is never mentioned.
10. John 11:35 "Jesus wept." (Although according to theologians, another verse is shorter in the Greek context, but this is considered to be the shortest in the English language.)
