Daniel 3:25-30

1. Established Character - chapter 1
* Daniel 1:6-21--even in a godless environment, they still had integrity--God blesses character
 2. Extreme Courage - chapter 3
* Daniel 3:1-18; Joshua 1:1-9
 3. Expressed Confidence - vss. 2-17
* Courage and confidence exhibited more than once-- they showed respect even when refusing to bow to the king
 4. Emphatic Conviction - vss. 18-22
* Job 13:15 --Courage and confidence must be rooted in conviction--our being in the fire might help others come to Christ
 5. Eternal Companion - vss. 23-25
* Jesus walks with us in the fire
 6. Eyewitness - vss. 24-25
* vs25 ...'lo, I see...' people are watching us--Nebuchadnezzar did not see Jesus until he was watching the men as they were in the fire
 7. Effective Change
* even Nebuchadnezzar was changed
 8. New Decree - vs.29
