2 Kings 2:1-14

1. Gilgal - to roll away vs. 1
* symbol of salvation by grace- our sins are 'Rolled Away'-can never have victory until accept salvation-we can know we are saved (I John 5:13)

2. Bethel - house of God vss. 2-3
* symbol of fellowship with God-168 hours in a week, yet we tend to give God only 1 hour on Sunday morning-

3. Jericho - fragrance of sweet smell vss.4-5
* symbol of resembling Christ- when the priest burned the incense, the sweet smell clings to their garments and people would know that they had been in the presence of God-does our life 'smell' like we live for Christ?

4. Jordan - descender or swooping down vss. 6-8
* symbol of servant-we need to be willing to serve others

5. Heaven came down - Spirit filled life vss. 9-14
* we need a closer relationship with God--
* keep our eyes on God and not on what is going on around us (chariot, whirlwind, ect.)
