## JONAH (Jonah's Preaching)

Jonah 3:1-9

Vs. 1 "...a second time..."

Vs. 2 (Jonah 1:2) "...go...preach..."

Vs. 3 (Jonah 1:3) "...arose...went..." (instead of) '...arose up to flee...'

Vs. 4

(8 word sermon-----it might have been short in quantity of words, but was intense in quality)

Vs. 5-9

Ninevites responded to a Jewish prophet  
Who told the king of the impending wrath?

Nineveh mobilized a large-scale repentance:

1.) outward sign of sorrow

(their prayers were re-directed from heathen gods to a holy, righteous God)
