<u>PSALM</u>	<u>TIMING</u>	<u>TYPE</u>
Psalm 22---Psalm of the Cross	Past	Dying Lamb (Death of Christ) Priest
Psalm 23---Psalm of Blessing	Present	Caring Shepherd (His care for His people) Prophet
Psalm 24---Psalm of the Crown	Future	Reigning Lord (His coming again) King

Psalm 22:1-31

"My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?..."

The accounts in the Gospels of Jesus' crucifixion report the fulfillment of many of the prophecies from Psalm 22.

Examples:

Psalm 22:7; Matthew 27:29, 30; Mark 15:16-20----scorn and ridicule of mobs

Psalm 22:15; Matthew 27:34; John 19:28----Jesus' thirst

Psalm 22:16; Mark 15:25; John 19: 17,18; John 20: 25-27----His pierced hands and feet

Psalm 22:18; Mark 15:24; John 19:23,24----soldiers gambled for His clothes

"My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?..." (Galatians 3:13, 14)
