

TEST 1

As an instructor, I must admit that I enjoy giving tests-----a good way for the student (and me!) to see how much they have retained. So, below is a test consisting of 10 questions----so each question counts 10 points. See how many you can answer without looking in your Bible. I hope that this is the first of MANY tests which you will be taking to see how much you remember. (The answers are under the answer section for each specific test.) All Scripture quotations are from the KJV unless otherwise specified.

1. In which book, chapter, and verse do we find that Jesus says, "I am the good shepherd."?
2. Which of the gospels do not begin (within the first couple of chapters) with an account of the birth of Christ?
3. What was created on the third day of creation?
4. Where was Paul when he was bitten by a viper?
5. Who shut the door and did not let Peter inside when he was released from prison?
6. Who fell out of a window during Paul's sermon?
7. What prophet performed CPR?
8. What two books of the Bible are credited to Luke as the author?
9. Which book of the Bible does not mention the name of God?
10. What book, chapter, and verse of the Scripture is considered to be the shortest verse---and what is the wording of the verse?
