* Numbers 13: 1-2, 17-20, 25-34

1. They pulled back right at the edge of promise.

* The spies were not asked to give their opinion -
they were asked to report vs 28,29 31-33

2. They made the mistake of following the crowd.

* All the spies saw the same thing, but had 2 different interpretations -
the crowd may not always be the right way- follow God not people

3. They enlarged their obstacles and didn't see
themselves through the eyes of God. 13:32-33

* Don't make your problem bigger than your God

4. They were looking to the past instead of the present. 14:1-4

* Don't let the victories of the past be the graveyards of the present -
remember what God has done in the past and be thankful- but do not
live in the past and miss the victories of the present-

5. They rebelled against their God given authority. 14:6-12
