Luke 19:1-10

1. Sinner's Condition vs. 2
 - * Romans 3:23; Romans 5:7,8 - We are never too "short" to get to Christ- no matter who or what we are, we can see Christ - He does not look at fame or fortune-all can come to Him without worrying about coming up "short"- Zacchaeus' short problem was really a heart problem-
2. Sincere Curiosity vs. 3-4
 - * He was to pass that way- we often look in the wrong places- Zacchaeus was a rich man, but he climbed a tree because he was desperate to see Jesus- don't let obstacles come between you and Christ-
3. Savior's Compassion vs. 5
 - * Jesus intentionally stopped where Zacchaeus was- Hebrews 4: 15,16
Jesus spoke Zacchaeus' name-
4. Scoffers' Criticism vs. 7
 - * They watched because they wanted to talk about people- (they gossip)- who are we to judge who Jesus calls?-
5. Supernatural Conversion vs. 6, 8
 - * Zacchaeus was joyful and began living a changed life-
6. Strong Confirmation vs. 9-10
 - * "...this day"...this house (Jesus spoke to Zacchaeus)
 - * "...he also is a son of Abraham--(Jesus spoke to the religious people telling them that Zacchaeus is changed)
