One of the reasons God allows us to experience trials is to prove that we belong to Him. When an unbeliever faces hardship, he will grow angry with God. He often sees life as a deal made with God—I will do this and God is supposed to bless me. When difficulty comes, that person thinks God has not upheld His end of the bargain. However, the person with a relationship with God will believe even when things go wrong.
