1. What is this righteousness?

* Our Christian life is not about perfection, but is about direction--Matthew 5:3, 10--'...for theirs is the Kingdom of heaven'

2. How hungering and thirsting can lead to this righteousness

* When we empty ourselves, God can fill our hunger and thirst for God's will--be sure to hunger and thirst for the right things--

First 4 beatitudes---common theme is emptiness and longing
Second 4 beatitudes---common theme is being filled; satisfaction
