Nehemiah 6:1-4

Nehemiah was rebuilding Jerusalem and would not be distracted

1. He was aware of the significance of his calling vs. 3

* '...I am doing a great work...' He had a burden and he would not give up nor give in--

2. He was aware of the circumstances - vs. 3

* He had critics and conflicts--But he continued his work

3. He was aware of the challenges - chapter 4

* We often face discouragement--Sanballet and Tobiah mocked Nehemiah and the workers--(Nehemiah 4:1-3) the workers began to think also that they could not complete the wall (4:10)--had to be reminded that God was with them (4:14)

4. He was aware of the dedication that was needed vs. 4

* His work for God required dedication
