# *If ye do return, He will deliver you*

## 1 Samuel 7:2-14

### 1. The occasion . vs. 2

\* has been 2 years without God's presence and power----  
Luke 2:44 '...supposing him to have been in the company...'  
do we suppose Jesus is with us, yet we have left Him behind--  
we need to know that He is in our midst--if He isn't we need to  
return to Him--

### 2. The preparation . vss. 3-6

\* vs3 '...If ye do return...'- we need to stay away from  
things that draw us away from God--instead we should  
return to Him--

### 3. The prayer . vss. 7-8

\* Mizpeh means place of judgement--  
vs6 '...poured out water...' represents forgiveness--  
Samual prayed for the people--the people were about to go out  
to fight and they requested prayer  
vs7 'Cease not to cry out unto the Lord...'

### 4. The power . vss. 9-13

\* and the shedding of the blood of the lamb, the people  
were victorious--
