## *Intercessory Prayer*

Mark 5:22-24, 35-41

Intro: Intercessory Prayer= when you pray on the behalf of someone else

1. The issue that drove him to Jesus.

\* vs 23—Jairus' love for his daughter caused him to leave his daughter and find Jesus—his desire brought him to Jesus—do our 'desires' bring us closer to Jesus, or do we let them drive us away from Him--

2. The purpose that directed him to Jesus.

\* His purpose was to find Jesus—he was willing to admit he did not have control, but he knew the One who did have control--

3. The miracle that delighted him in Jesus.

\* vs25-34—healing of woman with issue of blood—this was not a delay for Jesus—everything was still in His time—perhaps Jairus wondered about the 'delay' —He would have even a bigger miracle—his daughter was not only healed, but was resurrected— this was not what Jairus was expecting, but it was God's will--

The Process: (vss. 22-23)

- Jairus fell at His feet ( he humbled himself)
- He besought Him greatly
- He was honest about his situation (little girl...at the point of death...)
- He asked specifically for help (come...lay your hand on her...)
- He gave a reason for asking (that she may live)
