Luke 19:11-27

Occupy: to stay busy

1. Equal share - vss. 12-13
 - * Each received their blessing from the same source--
(one pound=3 months wages)--we each have a 'pound'
(the gospel message) we need to share it with others--
what are we doing with our 'pound'--

2. Opposing resentment - vs. 14
 - * The people rejected the nobleman--many reject Jesus too--
we should continue to live the life before them and continue to
pray for them--we plant the seed and God gives the increase--

3. Diligent action - vss. 16 & 18
 - * Steady commitment--even if someone rejects us, continue
to spread the gospel--let others know and see God's amazing
grace--

4. Anticipated an inspection - vs. 15, 17 & 19
 - * No one can prevent Christ's return--He will return and we will give
account for our actions--what are we doing with the 'pound' God
has given us--

5. Final admonition - vss. 20-21
 - * dont keep the message to yourself--occupy till He comes--
