What Causes Bitterness?:

- Willingly ignoring God's will. Ruth 1:20
* Elimelech and Naomi ignored God's plan --Ruth 1:1,2
- Refusing to release the offender. 2 Samuel 15:12 & 31
* We do not forgive and then the roots of bitterness grow
- The feeling of entitlement. Jonah 4:9
* Jonah felt he was entitled to the shade of the gourd and became bitter with God when the gourd died

What is Bitterness?: The signs of bitterness:

- Remembers details.
- Accuses others and Excuses self. James 3:14-18
* bitterness leads to evil doings
- Reveals Itself. James 3:10-11
* If you are bitter, nothing sweet shows in you

What Cures Bitterness?:

- Receive the grace of God. Hebrews 4:16; 12:15
- Take ownership.
* we need to take ownership of the desire to forgive
- Release both the offense and the offender. 1 Pt. 2:24 & Matt. 6:14-15
* Bitterness will never release you--you must release the bitterness
